



## GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT DRESS

### Rationale

Berri Primary School promotes a school identity through a set of guidelines for student dress based on school colours. The wearing of School uniform colours is an important safety factor in that we can clearly recognise students' association with our school. Clothing should be worn which allows freedom of movement and a level of comfort. At all times the shoulders must be covered.

The School Uniform Shop, stocks a wide range of affordable new and second-hand clothing in School colours.

When representing the school, students will be expected to wear school colours, including a polo shirt with the school logo.

### CLOTHING ITEMS WHICH FIT OUR DRESS GUIDELINES

- T-Shirts, Skivvy or Polo Shirt Red or Navy
- Windcheaters Red or Navy
- Shorts/Skirts Red or Navy
- Long Pants, Track pants, Jeans, Parachute Pants Red or Navy
- Girls Dress Red, Navy & White Checked
- Hats (Wide brimmed or Legionnaires) Red or Navy
- Suitable footwear for active play

Bike Helmets are required by law for all children who ride to school.

### CLOTHING WHICH IS UNSUITABLE FOR SCHOOL WEAR

**SHOES:** Thongs Bare Feet High heeled Shoes Strapless Sandals  
Clogs Ugg Boots

**CLOTHING:** Tank tops Sleeveless T-Shirts Bathes Open Weave (net) Tops  
Very Brief or Short Shorts/ Skirts/ Dresses Strapless and Halter Tops Shoe  
String Straps Clothing with offensive messages

**PEIRCINGS:** Facial piercings/ hooped or large earrings

### SUNSMART POLICY

In accordance with the School SunSmart Policy, the wearing of hats is compulsory. Hats must be wide brimmed or of a legionnaire design. Students also must wear tops which cover the shoulders and upper arm.
