### Our new playground is finally here....watch this funky space!








## **Wellbeing News**

You may notice there are some new signs around your child's classroom. The first is a 'Ready to Learn' Scale that each child is encouraged to self-assess their wellbeing before starting their day. It is a great way for teachers to monitor student wellbeing and address issues as soon as possible. It invites the children to 'check-in' with themselves- the first step to self-regulation (monitoring ones feelings). The next two posters are being used to help maintain a consistent approach with our co-regulation strategies, so that the process becomes embedded in our wellbeing program at Berri Primary School.
