### GROWING WITH GRATITUDE: A YOUTH WELLNESS AND POSITIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM

Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June was a Pupil Free Day which allowed all our staff, and some from neighbouring schools to join in a vast variety of learning activities that involved a lot of movement and fun.

Growing with Gratitude focuses on building one's resilience, happiness and mental well being in schools and homes.

Being made aware of alarming statistics such as 1 in 7 Primary school children experiencing mental ill health, 1 in 4 adolescents experiencing mental ill health, and 1 in 5 adults will experiencing mental health problems this year, made this day especially crucial and relevant for us all.

Our staff learnt the importance of the: 5 Habits of Happiness

**Gratitude:** Appreciating the things, the opportunities and the people in your life

**Empathy:** Seeing through another's eyes and understanding how someone is feeling

Kindness: Through what you say and what you do

**Positive reflection**: Focusing on the good things and understanding what has happened has happened, but what you do next is important

**Service:** Serving others without expecting anything in return.

The day involved us being actively engaged in so many different games, all of which can be incorporated into staff's weekly programs and daily practices and adapted so as to be suitable for children of all ages and year levels.








Congratulations to Nikoleta, Tia, Luke, Milla and Jordan who have all won a solo part.
















GET UP! STAND UP! SHOW UP!


